

## **Callington County Primary School.**

Mr Clifford Trevorrow took over from Mr W. Harris as Head Teacher of the school in September 1960. Mr Harris had been Head for over 35 years and was well liked and respected in the school and in Callington itself. I had spent a couple of weeks as a student teacher in the school in early 1960 prior to going to College.

I didn't realise at the time, but looking back I see what a profound effect Mr Trevorrow had on my career. I only spent one term working with him before he retired, but in that short time I formed the ideas and methods of Headship and management which I later put into practice when I had a school of my own. During my first couple of weeks as Deputy Head at the school I was aware of Mr Trevorrow watching me and checking up on what I was doing. After that he must have been satisfied for I was no longer aware of him observing me.

I owe an enormous debt of gratitude to Mr Trevorrow for the help and support he gave me and the wonderful example he set. He placed great importance to attention to detail and his strict adherence to time. His philosophy is set out in the last few pages of his history of the school on the following pages and I hope I was able to bring much of that to the work I did at Charmouth School.
